

LONDON PLAYING CARD CO.: for the courts see GOODALL.

In c.1885 GOODALL set up the LONDON PLAYING CARD Co. as a subsidiary outlet. It used its own versions of AS2 and 6; later the name was taken off but cards were still boxed as LONDON P.C. into at least the 1920's.
